

### **Article III Officers**

**Section 1.** The business and property belonging to the club shall be managed and controlled by the Officers of the club under the guidance of The Crumley House.

**Section 2.** The Officers shall be elected by the membership. In the case of a tie, a run-off election shall be held. All Officers must be club members in good standing.

**Section 3.** In case of a vacancy in the Officers by resignation, death, disqualification, or any other cause, the remaining Directors, by affirmative vote of majority, may thereof elect a successor.

**Section 4.** Any proposed rule changes, legally and properly worded, will be presented for consideration at any meeting. There the board can amend the proposed rule change. At the annual meeting, the Officers will approve or reject the proposed rule change. If the proposed rule change is approved, it will then be placed in the official rulebook for the following year.

**Section 5.** The written contracts of the club shall be executed on behalf of the club by the President and shall be approved through the Crumley House director.

### **Article IV Officers and Duties**

**Section 1. Officers:** The officers of the club shall be President, Vice-President, Show Manager, Secretary, Treasurer, High Point Registrar and 2 Board Members and such other officers as may be authorized from time to time by the members. Such officers shall hold office for a period of two (2) years and/or until their successors are elected.

**Section 2. President:** The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Association and shall preside at any and all meetings of the club. He/she shall see that the bylaws, rules and regulations of the club are enforced and shall perform all other duties that may be prescribed from time to time by the officers. He/she shall appoint all committees and also be the ex-officio of all committees.

**Section 3. Secretary:** The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all membership meetings and President meetings. He/she shall keep records of all memberships and status of said memberships. He/she shall collect the monies due to the club and turn them over to the Treasurer. He/she shall be ex-officio Secretary of all committees appointed by the President or by the Officers. He/she shall make a report of his/her office to all annual membership meetings and shall perform such other duties as prescribed by the officers from time to time.

**Section 4. Treasurer:** The treasurer shall receive all money turned over to him/her by the secretary and all other money. He/she shall account for all of the same by itemized statements in detail, to each meeting, when demanded.

**Section 5. High Point Registrar:** The High Point Registrar shall keep a running total of all points earned by horses/riders as received from member shows. These points are in relation to the High Point Awards.

**Section 6. Auditing of Accounts:** This Association shall conduct its affairs on the calendar year basis, beginning on January 1<sup>st</sup> and ending on the last day of December. An audit shall be made every January for the previous year.

**Section 7. Vacancies:** All vacancies in the officers of the Association shall be filled in by the President and affirmed by a majority vote of the members of the club for the unexpired term, and those so appointed shall serve until the election and acceptance of their duly qualified successor.
